We hope these pages inspire you, make you smile, and keep you connected with the vibrant spirit of our school. Happy reading!

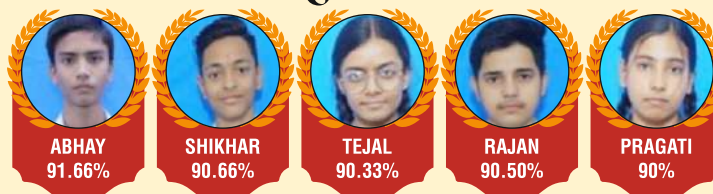

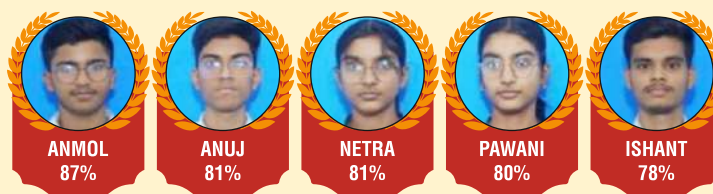

MUSIC CLASSES:
